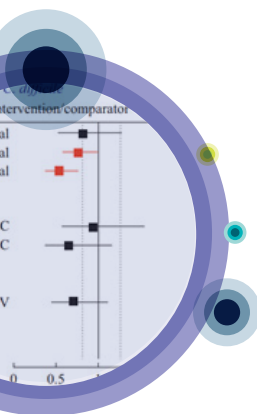
Understanding network meta-analysis

- Model checking and presentation of results with three or more treatments
